

How to identify wild garlic

Leaves will appear in the months:	- march - april	- (rarely march) april - may	- (rarely march) april - may	- may	- april - may
Scent:	- strong garlic scent	- no garlic scent	- no garlic scent	- no garlic scent	- no garlic scent
Flavour:	- garlicky	- harsh and bitter (poisonous!)	- harsh and bitter (poisonous!)	- bitter (highly poisonous!)	- bitter (highly poisonous!)
Leaf colour:	- lime green colour - elliptical / oblong - Glossy top side - Matt underside	- blue-green / dark green colour - glossy lime green underside	- green colour - narrow leaves - glossy on both sides	- darkgreen colour - elliptical leaves	 dark green colour on top lime green underside heart-shaped leaves
Firmness:	- very soft leaves	- firm leaves	- firm leaves / fleshy	- firm leaves	- firm leaves
Height of the plant:	- up to 30 cm	- up to 20 cm	- up to 40 cm	- up to 30 cm	- up to 50 cm
Stem:	- one leaf per stalk! - long and thin	- two leaves per stalk - reddish colouring on the stalk	- three or more leaves per stalk - no clear stalk visible	- one green stalk - no stalk on the leaf-parts	- long green stalks
Growth habit:	- in dense groups	- single or smaller groups	- single plants	- single plants	- smaller groups
Blossoms:	- star-shaped blossom - white blossoms	- bell-shaped flowers - white blossoms	 long-stalked flowers pale pink to violet colouring 	- green / whitish blossoms	- green / whitish blossoms
Toxicity:	- edible	- highly poisonous	- very highly / lethally toxic	- poisonous	- highly poisonous






